KIT LIST - FINLAND, HUSKY SAFARI

CLOTHING included in Finland - Winter overalls, Boots and Mittens

EQUIPMENT included in Finland - Sleeping bag and liner for overnight in wilderness cabin, bath towels, bed linen.

LUGGAGE

Holdall/Suitcase, to transport out to Finland
Daysack, 35 - 40 litre capacity (for overnight cabin on the Husky safari. This travels in the sled, not on your back)

FOOTWEAR

Winter insulated boots, provided
Evening footwear to pad a round the cabin

CLOTHING

*Work on the 'layer system', so you have the ability to put clothes on/off as the temperature or activity changes.
It will be the wind chill on your extremities that can be the most damaging (effect of cold).*

Duvet jacket
Thick fleece or woolen sweater
Thermal base layers
Underwear
T shirts, short or long
Hat(s), warm and windproof, with ear cover.
Thin hand gloves, wearing when working
Gloves/Mittens, don't let your hands get cold!
Socks, 2 pair of thick and thin as a min, wool is good.
Trousers
Buff or scarf/balaclava, have the ability of cover the face skin
Swimming costume?
Night clothes, not used for snowshoeing

Don't underestimate how quickly you cool down in cold temperatures once you stop moving. Ensure you have additional warm clothing in your daysack to put on.

DOCUMENTS/MONEY

Passport
Flight Ref details/document
Travel Insurance details
Spare photo ID
Spare passport photo

Currency cash (Finland works in Euros)
Credit card
Hard copy of important documents

EQUIPMENT

Sunglasses (+ hard case), essential to prevent snow blindness.
Ski goggles, maybe preferable to the above
Thermos flask
Torch (LED head torches are best + spare batteries)

Normal vision glasses (if worn) (+ hard case)
Pocket knife
Medical kit (see website for checklist)

Mobile phone (+ charger)
Power bank, no electricity in wilderness cabin
Plug adaptor

Camera (+ batteries + charger)

Wash kit

Sleeping bags and liners are provided for the wilderness cabin

Reading/writing material
Needle/thread
Spare laces
Combination lock(s)

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
