

CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT

MOROCCO TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE TOURS

This Clothing and Equipment list is a guide to what you should bring. It is not an instruction, and it is not exhaustive. Adjust as you see fit according to your preferences and experience.

Important points:

- It's northern Morocco, in high summer. It'll be hot.
- While the trekking element is short, it is still exposed to the elements for a number of hours per day.
- It can still rain!
- The trails are typical mountain trails; solid but uneven, rocky. Wear boots, ankle protection is important. If you wear trainers, or trail shoes, you risk ankles going over!

LUGGAGE

Daysack, for carrying daily essentials
Optional waterproof liner

FOOTWEAR

Walking boots (preferably waterproof)
Evening footwear

CLOTHING for trekking

Waterproof jacket (essential) & trousers (advisable)
Trekking trousers, or shorts
T shirts, short or long sleeve (be wary of the sun)
Socks
Sun hat, or similar

CLOTHING, touring

To suit the environment

EQUIPMENT

Sleeping bag, light summer one will do
Liner (if used)
Water bottles (drinking)
Sunglasses (+ hard case)
Normal vision glasses (if worn) (+ hard case)
Trekking poles (optional)
Personal first aid kit (geared to you)

Mobile phone (+ charger)
Plug adaptor

Camera (+ batteries + charger)

Wash kit
Towel

DOCUMENTS/MONEY

Passport
Visa if required
Flight Ref details/document
Immigration details (hotel address 1st night, we supply)
Travel Insurance details

Currency cash (Moroccan Dirhams is a closed currency)
Credit card
Hard copy of important documents

USEFUL EXTRAS

Dirty wash bag
Guide book
Reading/writing material
Needle/thread
Spare laces
Combination lock(s)
Power bank (for mobiles, if required)
